BARCELONA

1. DAY Arrival

Arrival at Barcelona airport, assistance at the airport by our guide and transfer by bus to the hotel.

Check-in at the hotel and afternoon is free for your own activities. We end the day with dinner at the hotel.

2. DAY City tour Barcelona

Breakfast at the hotel. Meeting with our guide at the hotel to start a bus tour of the city. The tour ends at Plaça de Catalunya, where we have a perfect starting point for the 1,200-meter-long pedestrian street of La Rambla and Barri Gotic's old town. For those who wish, there is the opportunity to discover these famous areas together with our tour guide. We will cross, among other things, the old town of the charming streets of Barri Gòtic and we will cross the Plaça de Sant Jaume. On the way to the port we also visited the huge La Boqueria market.

3. DAY Barcelona in the footsteps of Gaudí

Breakfast at the hotel. Meeting with the guide at the hotel to visit the buildings and works of the famous architect Antoni Gaudí. It is an excursion that begins in the Park Güell, where Gaudí spent many of his years of life. Here we are also offered impressive views of the city. Then we went to the most famous building in Gaudi and Barcelona, La Sagrada Familia. We make an exterior walk around the powerful church that began to be built in 1882 and is not yet finished.

4. DAY Montserrat and the Parés Baltà vineyard

After breakfast we left the big city for a full day tour with our bus. The first stop is the famous mountain and monastery of Montserrat, a powerful symbol of the Catalans. The patron saint of Catalonia, the Black Madonna, is preserved in the monastery church, where the famous choir of the monastery often stands in front of her hymn. We continue to Pacs del Penedès to visit the Parés Baltà vineyard. Since the end of the 18th century, the vineyards have flourished on the farm, which is now run by the Cusiné family. We take a tour of the cozy farm and we have the opportunity to taste some of the wines. At night, we recommend you to see the famous water play in the fountain "Font magica de Montjuïc" in Plaça Espanya.

5. DAY Barcelona - city of origin

After breakfast, transfer to Barcelona airport.
