

# MALTA

Explore an island where so many cultures left their tracks

## 1. DAY Arrival - 3 cities

Arrival and lunch at Don Berto Restaurant in Birgu. After we board a traditional Maltese Boat called a dghajsa for harbour cruise. Tour of 3 cities - three fortified cities of Birgu, Senglea and Cospicua. Visit of the Inquisitor's Palace. Check in at the hotel and dinner.

## 2. DAY Full Day Valletta Tour & Valletta Food Trail

After breakfast the group will be split into 2 groups, each doing its itinerary. While group 1 is going on Food Trail (tapas + 2 glasses of local wine/water at King's Own Band Club, traditional Maltese Ftira accompanied by local beer at Nenu – the Artisan Baker, and Imqaret, date filled pastry dessert and ice-cream at Panorama Restaurant at the British Hotel), group 2 has Classic Cultural Valletta tour with St. John's Co – Cathedral and Grand Master's Palace. They will meet at the Upper Barrakka Gardens with spectacular view of the Grand Harbour, Bighi, Fort St. Angelo and the Three Cities and they then swap. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

## 3. DAY Full Day Mdina & Rabat incl. Maltese lunch

After breakfast we will first stop in Mosta for a quick visit of the Mosta Dome – the 4<sup>th</sup> largest dome in Europe. Then visit of Malta's ancient capital city, Mdina, one of the world's finest examples of a still-inhabited medieval city. After lunch in Mdina we walk to Rabat for a visit of the St. Paul's Catacombs, the oldest and largest evidence of Christianity on the Maltese islands. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

## 4. DAY Full Day Gozo Tour

Gozo is the island where Calypso is said to have held the Greek hero Odysseus captive for seven years. We will first stop in Xaghra with Ggantija Prehistoric Temples built more than 5000 years ago. Then we go to Victoria, Gozo's Capital City. Its Citadel has been a landmark and focal point on the Island since at least 1500 B.C. Today's cathedral (1697-1711) is a superb example of Mediterranean baroque. Lunch at local restaurant. We then drive to Dwejra where you get to see the "Azure Window" whose arch has been created by the constant pounding of the water. This unfortunately is no longer there, as it collapsed earlier this year due to storms. However there are still wonders to see like Fungus Rock and Inland Sea. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

## 5. DAY Departure

Departure after the breakfast.
