CHAMPAGNE & BURGUNDY

Discover lands of famous wines

1. DAY Arrival to Reims

Arrival in Reims, the capital of champagne. Check in the hotel in the city center and dinner nearby.

2. DAY Reims, the capital of Champagne

After breakfast, we go with our local guide for a guided walking tour of the city known for its magnificent Gothic cathedral Notre-Dame de Reims, which has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1991. In the afternoon guided visit of Maison Mumm renowned for its Cordon Rouge, with beautiful wine cellars and Champagne tasting.

3. DAY Reims - Hautvillers - Cumières

Departure for a guided tour of the village of Hautvillers, known as the birthplace of Champagne. Then visit a family-run vineyard of Ghislain and Marie-José Tribaut, just outside Epernay. In the afternoon a cruise with commentary aboard the "Champagne Vallée" boat discoveing vineyards and villages of Champagne on the banks of Marne River.

4. DAY Champagne road and Épernay

After breakfast we start the day with a garden visit Le Jardin de l'Hôtel de Ville in Epernay and later guided visit on foot of the majestic avenue de Champagne. After lunch, head to Ay and visit the "Cité du Champagne", registered as a UNESCO world heritage site. The tour includes the House of the oldest champagne winegrowers' cooperative, the cellars, the Museum of Champagne's Work Crafts and the vineyards of Ay and ends with a Champagne tasting. Then follow the Champagne tourist route to the heart of the Reims mountain regional nature park.

5. DAY Troyes - Dijon

After breakfast we go to Troyes and spend the morning strolling the city's lively medieval streets, which are flanked by half-timbered buildings and medieval churches. After lunch and visit of Château de Pommard we will go to the medieval city of Dijon, capital of Burgundy and world-famous for its mustard and its wine. We will have a guided visit of the city hall lounges. Then check in your hotel in the centre of Dijon or Beaune.

6. DAY Dijon - Beaune

After breakfast drive through the road of great vintages, proudly called the Champs-Elysees of Bourgogne, with passionate wine expert. We will pass by the famous villages of Gevrey Chambertin, Vosne-Romanée, Nuit Saint Georges etc. Then visit the Château du Clos Vougeot, a Historic Cistercian winery set in the heart of Burgundy's Grand Cru Vineyards. After we visit Fallot mustard factory finished by a mustard tasting.

7. DAY Beaune - Departure

After breakfast we will have a guided visit of the "Hospices de Beaune". Departure.
