## 1. DAY Malaga - Cordoba

Breakfast. Tour of Cordoba (courtyard flowers festival – available in May). Lunch at local bodega. Rest of the day free at leisure. Dinner on your own. Overnight in Cordoba.

#### 3. DAY Cordoba

Breakfast. Tour of Medina Azahara. Lunch at an andalusian courtyard complex (food market). Tour of Cordoba (alcazar & palacio de viana). Rest of the day free at leisure. Dinner on your own. Overnight in Cordoba.

4. DAY Cordoba - Montilla - Baena - Alcala la Real - Granada
Breakfast. Check-out. Daytrip from Cordoba to Granada, where we will
discover Andalusian wines, olive oil, castles & bullrings. Arrival to
Montilla, Wine cellar tour, including wine tasting of 3 types produced
in the area. Continuation to Baena, olive oil factory tour ("almazara"),
including degustation lunch. Departure towards Alcalá La Real, La
Mota fortress tour. Continuation to Granada. Welcome dinner inside
Granada's bullring building. Overnight in Granada.

#### 5. DAY Granada

Breakfast. Tour of the impressive Alhambra palaces & gardens. Degustation lunch at a local "Carmen" (typical grenadian house) in front of the walls of the Alhambra. Transfer to the Albaycin, Tour of the hidden corners of this quarter where we will be able to enter to some private "carmenes". Return to the hotel and time to relax. Flamenco show with dinner at a real gipsy cave. Overnight in Granada.

## 6. DAY Granada - Alpujarras - Costa Tropical - Malaga

Breakfast. Day trip: gardens, tropical products plantation & sun. Departure from Granada to Nigüelas. Garden tour, including french style private garden from Müller family & romantic garden Casa Zayas. Arrival to the Tropical Coast (Almuñecar area). Tropical products land / plantation tour with local expert. Lunch in the country house inside the "finca" (plantation). Arrival to Malaga, check-in, time for rest and explore the city on your own. Farewell dinner at local bodega next to roman amphitheatre. Overnight in Malaga.

### 7. DAY Malaga

Breakfast. Tour of Malaga: Picasso birthplace. Lunch at local restaurant located in Malaga port. Transfer to the airport.
