The first weekend
in February

Gran Canaria blooming white

1. DAY Arrival to Gran Canaria / Las Palmas

Arrival to Gran Canaria, transfer and check-in at the hotel. Dinner at the hotel.

2. DAY Almond blossom party

After breakfast you will leave for Tejeda. This village is known for its huge areas of almond trees that during the months of January and February create beautiful white tapestry. The town celebrates its flowering with the Almond Flower Festival. During the visit you will be able to enjoy the activities of almond tree blossoming, craft stalls and traditional Canarian music. Dinner at the hotel.

3. DAY Visit Las Palmas

After breakfast you will discover the oldest quarter of Las Palmas, called Vegueta, which is a maze of narrow, cobblestone streets, and tiny shaded squares, to see the colourful market and the Columbus House. Pass by Plaza Santa Ana with its bronze statues in honour of the dogs, which gave the Canary Islands their name (canum in Latin), the songbirds were later named after the islands. You will then enjoy a panoramic tour of the city, stop at Altavista, with its magnificent views of Las Palmas, Las Canteras Beach and the harbour. Dinner at the hotel.

4. DAY Grand Tour

Leaving Las Palmas de Gran Canaria to Bandama, the volcanic crater. You will continue through the agricultural town of San Mateo, set in a fertile high plain. The road goes climbing until Cruz de Tejeda is reached, 1.450 meters above sea level. You will continue to Valleseco and then to Teror. Teror is a classic Canarian rural town with old houses whose wooden balconies are worthy of notice. The church, Basílica de Nuestra Señora del Pino, in honour of the Patron Saint of the island, was built to commemorate the apparition of the Virgin in a pine tree in 1481. Continuing along the base of the mountains to Arucas, the third most populated city of the island located in the middle of a fertile banana region. Sugar cane is also grown to supply the rum distilleries there. Dinner at the hotel.

5. DAY Departure

Departure after breakfast.

The Almond Blossom Festival is celebrated every year in Tejeda, the highest town of Gran Canaria. During the months of January and February blooming almond trees create beautiful white tapestry that covers whole area seemingly in a silky mist. This gives another view of the island which is called a "Miniature Continent" due to the different climates and variety of landscapes.
