

NORTH BOHEMIAN HIKING TOUR

5 trips in sandrocks of Northern Bohemia

DAY 1

Arriving at the Vaclav Havel airport Prague, transfer to main railway station Prague and then by train to hotel, free time and dinner at the hotel

DAY 2

Transfer to Tisá and hiking in Sandrocks „Tisá Walls“ and ascent to „Děčínský sněžník mountain“ and transfer back to the hotel for a dinner

DAY 3

Short transfer to Jetřichovice and round trip via Mary´s Viewpoint, Jetřichovice sandwalls, Peak Ostroh, Kassel desk and back to Jetřichovice following the transfer to the hotel, dinner

DAY 4

Leaving directly hotel to viewpoint „Bird Stone“ and Vysoká Lípa, passing Ruins of Valley Mill to Šaunštejn Rock Castle and Small Pravčická Gate, dinner at the hotel

DAY 5

Directly from the hotel to Kamenice pass with boat trip in the Wild Gorge, via Hřensko to Pravčická gate and then by Gabriela trail back to the hotel. Dinner in děčín in the local brewery Captain.

DAY 6

Transfer to Königstein (next to the Bad Schandau in Germany) and short trip to Fortress Königstein, transfer to Bad Schandau and then by train to Prague, time for your own and dinner in the local pub in the city centre.

DAY 7

2 hours walking tour in the historic city centre, time for shopping and departure from Prague airport

Bohemian Switzerland, also known as Czech Switzerland, is a picturesque region in the north-western Czech Republic. It lies on the Czech side of the Elbe Sandstone Mountains north of Děčín on both sides of the Elbe River. It extends eastward into the Lusatian Mountains and westward into the Ore Mountains. Its highest elevation is the mountain Děčínský Sněžník at 726m above sea level. It has been a protected area (ChKO Labske Piskovce) since 1972. The region along the right side of the Elbe became a national park on January 1, 2000, the České Švýcarsko National Park. The National Park is adjacent to the Saxon Switzerland National Park (Sächsische Schweiz) in Germany.
